### Primary Responsibilities

- Assist in refurbishing used machinery for resale. This will encompass all aspects of that process including: initial evaluation, determining what parts will be replaced and what will be refurbished, installing parts and rebuilding mechanical components, completing machine reassembly, and fully test running machines to ready them for resale.
- Providing technical assistance to customers over the phone. This will require a good understanding of the tuning process, our machinery and its intended functions as well as excellent troubleshooting skills to determine causes of problems, and providing solutions.
- Offering support for our area technicians around the US and Canada. This will include, using machine diagrams to find part numbers, creating parts shipments, and other activities as needed.

### Qualified candidates will have:

- At least 5 years of experience in the ski/snowboard service industry
- At least 1 year of ski tuning experience using Wintersteiger or similar machinery
- Demonstrated ability to take ski equipment through the entire tuning process
